Default CCA is 50% NYS Renewable, O&R is 6.45% NYS Renewable in 2024.

Once on the CCA rate you can still <u>check the O&R</u>

<u>rate</u>, which changes monthly.



## TOWN OF TUXEDO COMMUNITY POWER Rates Options

•50% NYS Renewable Option: 50% of your electricity supply is matched by Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) provided by New York State renewable power plants (hydropower, wind, solar). The remaining 50% is matched by RECs sourced from other U.S. Renewable electricity sources. The 50% Renewable Option is not counted as 100% renewable by New York State.

•100% NY Renewable Option: 100% of your electricity supply is matched by Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) provided by New York State renewable power plants (hydropower, wind, solar).



#### **Automatic Enrollment**

Eligible O&R customers are enrolled on an opt-out basis except for....



### **Automatic Enrollment**

#### Not automatically enrolled:

- Customers already contracted with a third-party electricity supplier/ESCO
- Demand customers (usually commercial)
- Customers who have placed a block on their account
- Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) recipients
- Customers on Time of Use accounts

#### **How Will CCA Affect Me?**

Eligible customers will be automatically enrolled unless they take action (opt-out) before the program begins.



## Opt Out Details

#### All eligible customers receive info packet

- Explains benefits, terms, conditions
- Provides opt-out options
- Includes FAQ

#### **Opt-out options**

- Mail (prepaid)
- Online
- Help Line, Monday to Friday, 9 to 5

#### 30-day initial opt-out period

- No exit fees at any time
- Exit at any time afterward



## Timeline

#### All eligible customers receive info packet

Early June

#### 30-day initial opt-out period

 Early June – early July However, anyone can opt-out <u>at any time</u> during the program.

#### Launch

- August 1, 2024
- Default supply: 50% NYS Renewable
- New supplier (Constellation CCA) identified
   on page 2 of O&R bill



## WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE? CCA vs. ESCOs (Third Party Suppliers)

### CCA programs offer:

- No individual contracts for consumers
- No exit fees
- Fixed rates



## Frequently Asked Questions

- Does this program impact the reliability of your electricity?
  - No, your utility continues to deliver your electricity and provides the same service whether you participate in the program or not.
- What if you want to change your supply choice?
  - Once the program launches, you may call the helpline or fill out the Enrollment/Change form on the website to change your supply selection, opt-out, or opt back into the program, with no fees or penalties.

## Frequently Asked Questions

- Do you have to stay in the program the entire time?
  - No, you may opt-out or opt back in at any time with no fees or penalties.
- Can you participate if you have your own solar panels or if you participate in community solar?
  - Yes, even if you use solar power, you are still required to have a supplier on your O&R bill to cover any electricity not provided by your solar.
- What happens when the program ends?
  - When the contract ends, your municipality may choose to renew participation in the program. If not, you will automatically switch back to O&R selecting your supply on your behalf.
