

**CHALLENGE TO REGISTRATION OF VOTER**  
**(§5-220 OF Election Law)**

**To the Board of Elections - Orange County:**

I, Claudio Guazzoni de Zanett, being duly sworn, depose and states:

1. I reside at 27 East Summit Road, Tuxedo Park, New York 10987.
2. In accordance with section §5-220 of the Election Law, I challenge the registration of [REDACTED] purportedly residing according to the registration at [REDACTED] Tuxedo Park, NY 10987. I believe that the said registration should be cancelled as that person is not a resident of the County of Orange within the terms set forth in the Election Law.
3. The reasons and facts supporting my belief that the said registration should be cancelled are an investigation of the subject voter's residence including checking open-source sites (social media, google and other search engines, etc) and restricted data base platforms that are used by law enforcement and private investigators. This included inquiries with IRBsearch, IDI core, and TLOxp/Transunion.

I am informed that each of these databases provides real time identification and location of people, assets, and their interrelationships. Further, I am informed that each of these database platforms continuously collects and focusses information provided by thousands of different sources. The most common of these sources include, address checks, forwarding address checks, phone number checks, drivers licenses, bankruptcy checks, foreclosure checks, civil court records, UCC filings, utilities provided to a household, criminal and traffic records, vehicle registrations, aliases, liens and judgements, properties and ownership, notices of default, corporate affiliations, professional licenses, associates, hunting, fishing, and professional licenses, student records, voter registration records, weapon permits, e-mail addresses, business affiliations, social network posts, and

license plate reader information. The investigative report is furnished herewith. In addition I have caused a search of the United States Postal Service National Change of Address database to be performed and that report is also provided to the Board of Elections herewith.

4. Moreover, I believe that, based upon my observations of the voter's registration address that this person does not inhabit the subject premises. I respectfully urge the Board of Elections to, under the provisions of the Election law, have the Sheriff check and confirm:


- monthly mortgage payments made on this home;
- annual property taxes paid for this home;
- property/homeowner's insurance bills and payments;
- leases, rental agreements, rental receipts, sources and proof of income of the rents paid;
- STAR applications and exemptions;
- professional licenses, including law, accounting licenses, evidencing said address;
- Federal, state and city tax returns;
- Employment records, including pay checks;
- Proof of Notification to Post Offices of change of address changes
- Driver's licenses bearing this claimed address;
- Motor Vehicle registrations bearing this claimed address;
- Motor vehicle leases bearing this address;
- Life, disability insurances bearing this address;
- Fire, house and other insurances bearing this address;
- Proof of service, receipt and payment for all utility bills, including but not limited to, TV, internet, streaming services, telephones, cell phones, gas, electric, bearing this address;
- Mail received bearing this address;
- Bank, credit and/or debit cards, or other financial statements, addresses of personal bank accounts;
- Retirement, Investment, Pension and other financial statements
- Educational records bearing this address;
- Medical and Health Insurance invoices, coverage and records bearing this address;

- Political contributions and correspondence;
- Contributions to any and all organizations, nonprofit or otherwise, from this claimed address;
- Knowledge of names and addresses of neighbors and their families, near this address, and dated proof of interaction;
- Letterheads, stationery, business cards, family photographs evidencing connection with said address;
- Receipts and addresses for all groceries, clothes, furniture, laundry, household items and appliances purchased, and tithes/offerings given to religious, charitable and service organizations, including non-profits bearing said address;
- proof of repairs or maintenance done at claimed address


The reason for this challenge are based upon my personal knowledge and observation and the investigative report furnished to the Board of Elections herewith.

I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that the foregoing statement made by me on May 6, 2024, is a truthful disclosure of the reasons for my belief that the registered voter therein named is not qualified to continue to be registered in the election district in which he/she is now registered.
